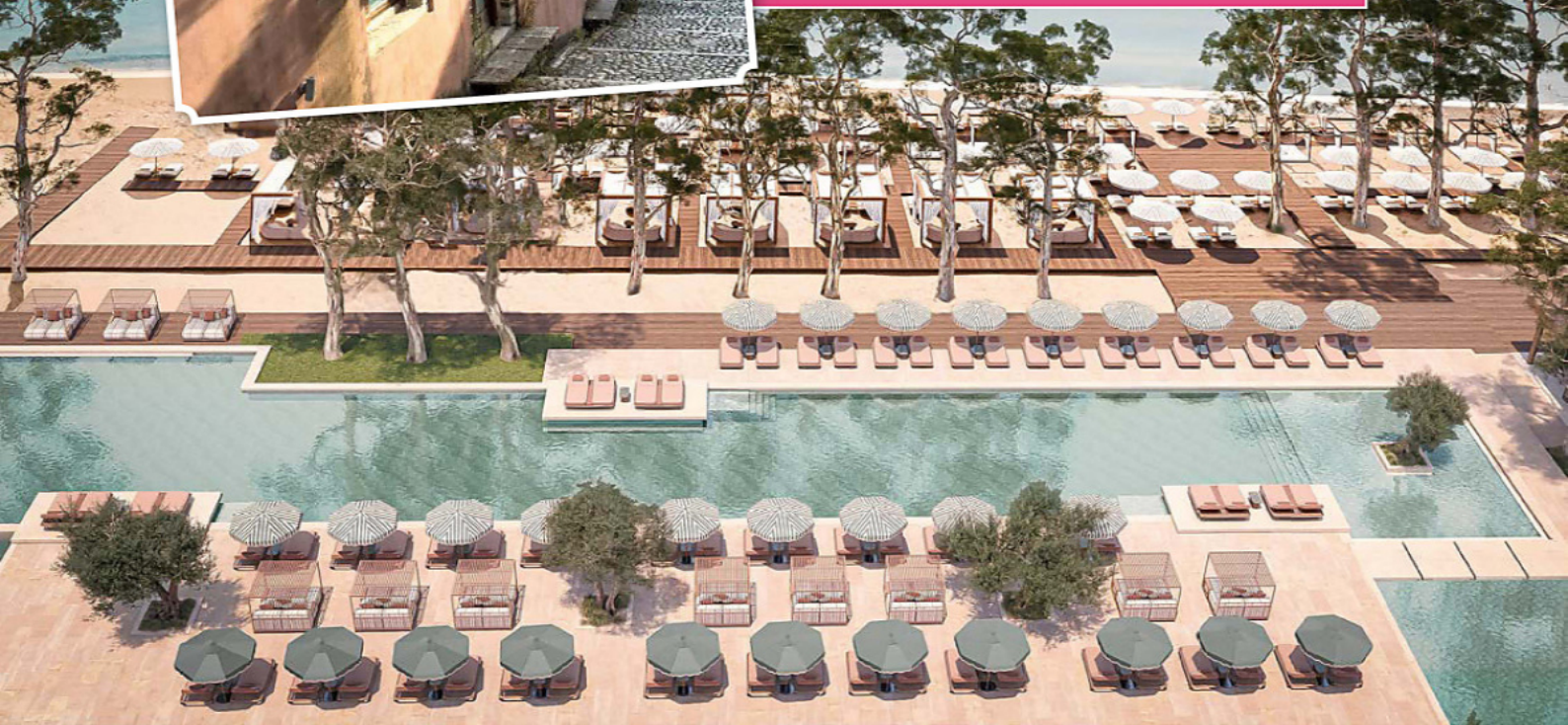
UNFORGETTABLE HONEYMOONS
