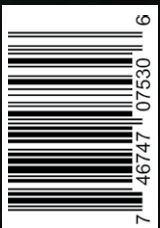

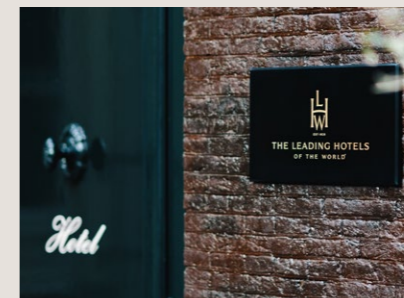

THE DYLAN AMSTERDAM — CANALSIDE ELEGANCE IN THE NINE STREETS

Amsterdam's Nine Streets district is a neighborhood of contrasts: cobbled lanes lined with independent boutiques, artisan galleries, and cafés, all framed by the city's iconic canals. At its heart sits **The Dylan Amsterdam**, a hotel that embodies the city's layered identity—historic yet modern, intimate yet cosmopolitan.

A HERITAGE HOTEL WITH MODERN SOUL

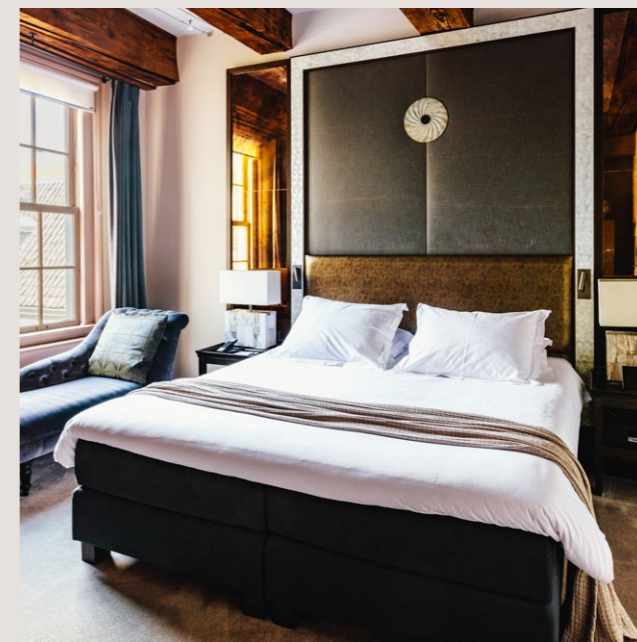
The Dylan occupies a series of seventeenth century canal houses along the Keizersgracht, one of Amsterdam's most storied waterways. Inside, the property balances historic architecture with contemporary refinement. Rooms and suites are individually designed, blending warm woods, soft textiles, and curated artworks. The effect is understated luxury—spaces that feel personal, inviting, and deeply connected to the city's rhythm.

Guests can choose from canal-view suites, garden-facing rooms, or loft-style accommodations tucked beneath original beams. Each space reflects a different facet of Amsterdam: the intimacy of its courtyards, the grandeur of its waterways, and the creativity of its design culture.

CULINARY EXCELLENCE

Dining at The Dylan is an experience in itself. Restaurant Vinkeles is a Michelin two-star destination offering modern French cuisine in an 18th-century bakery setting. The setting—brick walls, vaulted ceilings, and candlelight—creates an atmosphere of quiet drama.

For lighter moments, **Bar Brasserie OCCO** provides a lively setting for cocktails, afternoon tea, or casual dining. Seasonal menus highlight regional ingredients, while the bar's inventive mixology reflects Amsterdam's cosmopolitan spirit.







THE NINE STREETS LIFESTYLE

Step outside The Dylan and you are immediately immersed in the Nine Streets. This district is a labyrinth of fashion boutiques, vintage shops, and artisan studios. It's a place where locals and visitors alike wander between canal bridges, pausing at cafés or discovering hidden courtyards.

The Dylan's bicycles—crafted from recycled Dutch frames—offer guests the perfect way to explore, weaving through the canals toward landmarks like the Anne Frank House, the Rijksmuseum, or the Van Gogh Museum.
